JUSTIN MICHAEL DUVAL - BASS/ CREATOR / PRODUCER

Justin Michael Duval is a New York-based performer, creator, and producer with extensive experience across Broadway-bound development, national tours, cruise entertainment, and leading regional theatres. He is currently working on the Broadway-bound *Chez Joey*, directed by Tony Goldwyn with choreography by Savion Glover, and starring Tony Award winner Myles Frost. His performance credits include the First National Tour of *Girl From the North Country*, as well as appearances at Arena Stage, La Jolla Playhouse, The Old Globe, Florida Studio Theatre, Moonlight Stage Productions, and La Mirada Theatre, among others.

Known for his rich baritone voice, grounded stage presence, and strong storytelling instincts, Justin is frequently cast in leading and character roles that balance heart, humor, and emotional depth. Justin is the creator and star of *Righteous Harmony*, a harmony-driven concert experience inspired by the music of the Righteous Brothers and reimagined through a contemporary lens. As producer and lead performer, he has overseen the project's development from concept through realization, including repertoire, arrangements, branding, and presentation.

Shawn W. Smith is a multifaceted performer whose work has been seen and heard by audiences around the world. He has produced and performed numerous solo concerts in New York City and Los Angeles and has collaborated with celebrated artists including Marc Shaiman, Alex Newell, and Stephen McKinley Henderson. 



5. STAGE NOTES

- Piano is positioned Stage Right
- Guitar is positioned Stage Left
- Vocalists perform primarily downstage
- Floor wedges preferred; in-ear monitors acceptable and encouraged for larger venues
- Clear upstage-to-downstage access required for movement of stools and mic stands



4. STAGE PLOT – AUDIENCE PERSPECTIVE (FULL RHYTHM SECTION)

The following layout illustrates placement of performers, instruments, monitors, mic stands, stools, and auxiliary items. Vocalists perform on wireless microphones. Mic stands and stools begin stored upstage and are brought downstage only when needed.

This Artist Rider shall be attached to and become an integral part of the Cruise Engagement Agreement dated _____ by and between Righteous Harmony LLC (hereinafter referred to



as "Artist") and _____ (hereinafter referred to as "Cruise Line / Vessel"), covering performances on _____.

In the event of any conflict between the Cruise Engagement Agreement and this Artist Rider, this Artist Rider shall govern.

1. SHOW OVERVIEW

- Performers: TENOR & BASS
- Runtime: 90 minutes (2 x 45-minute sets)
- Vocals: Wireless handheld microphones
- Music: Cruise-provided band / rhythm section
- Charts and musical materials provided by Artist in advance

2. CRUISE-PROVIDED BAND & MUSICAL DIRECTION

The cruise line will provide a professional rhythm section, typically consisting of:

- Piano / Keys
- Guitar
- Bass
- Drums

All arrangements are fully charted. Charts will be advanced to the ship's Musical Director. Rehearsal scheduling to be coordinated with the ship's music department.

3. STAGE & LIFT (WHEN AVAILABLE)

- Standard cruise theatre stage is acceptable
- Use of a stage lift for the opening moment is requested when available
- Lift usage is optional and subject to vessel capability and safety approval
- Lift cue to be coordinated with lighting and stage management

4. STAGE LAYOUT – AUDIENCE PERSPECTIVE

- Upstage: Cruise-provided band (Piano, Guitar, Bass, Drums)
- Downstage: TENOR (DSL) and BASS (DSR)
- Mic stands and stools stored upstage and brought downstage only when needed
- Open playing space preserved for movement and storytelling
- Lift area utilized downstage center when available
